


How to use the forge to contribute to PrestaShop


How to use the forge to contribute to PrestaShop

First, you need to create an account to use the bug tracker. You can do it here: <http://forge.prestashop.com/secure/Signup!default.jsps>

2. Choose the project: PrestaShop version 1.4 or 1.5, Prestashop Native Modules & Themes,
3. Choose the issue type: "bug" or "improvement",
4. Submit
